Tournament Rules and Regulations

1. Bowlers must mark classification—Class A, Parent with child 19 years old or over; Class B, Parent with child 16 years old through 18 years old; Class C, Parent with child 12 years old through 15 years old; Class D Bantam, Parent with child 11 years of age, or under, at time of entry .
2. Child must be blood, legally adopted or stepchild.
3. Parent may enter tournament as many times as he/she wishes; partner must be a different child.
4. Bowlers must present USBC sanction card if high score protection is desired. Eligible non-members of USBC have option of paying out \$5.00 participation fee before bowling. (Unattached membership cards will be issued by USBC.)

5. Handicap for Classes A, B, C, and D will be 90 per cent of difference between HIGHEST LEAGUE AVERAGE and 220 scratch.
6. Entrants will use their highest USBC sanctioned league average based on a minimum of 21 games for the 2007-2008 season. If current 21 game average as of April 1, 2009 is 10 or more pins above 2007-2008 season's average, current average must be used. If no average last year, use highest current USBC sanctioned average 21 games or more as of April 1, 2009. Committee will handicap all others on a basis of scores rolled in previous Tournaments. If no average established, average will be determined by Tournament Committee. Max. Hcp.-75 Pins.
